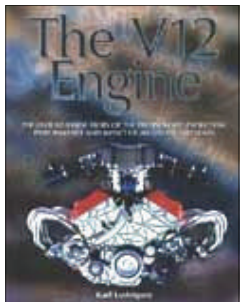

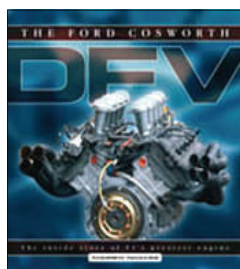

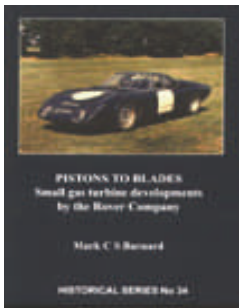


THE FORD COSWORTH DFV: The Inside Story of F1's Greatest Engine

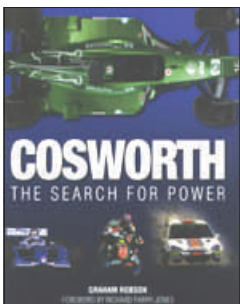
Small Gas Turbine Developments By The Rover Company

Excellent photos & technical drawings showing gearing, drives etc.

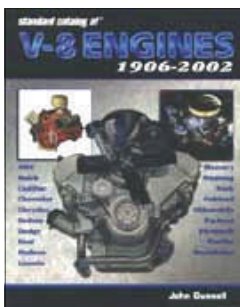

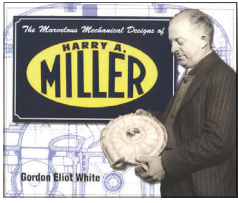

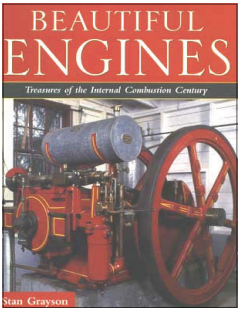
